



Lake Darpo Rules and Regulations

1. A \$75.00 non-refundable fee will be required at least 2 weeks in advance to rent the Clubhouse. An additional \$25.00 deposit is required to cover the cost of damages incurred during the rental and/or cleanup afterwards. The full service RV site is \$12.00 per night while the other RV site is \$10.00 per night. All other buildings will not require a fee, however, screened shelters will need to be reserved through the Recreation Department.
2. No alcoholic beverages, controlled substances (illegal drugs), hunting or firearms are allowed in the park area. This does not include the firing range supervised by the Sheriff's department.
3. No outside fires may be started without a permit. No camping without a permit. Permits may be obtained by contacting the County Recreation Director @ 398-4700.
4. There will be no swimming allowed unless a county employed lifeguard is on duty.
5. Only electric trolling motored boats are allowed in the lake. All coast guard approved boating regulations will be enforced, including the use of proper flotation devices while occupying a boat.
6. All South Carolina Wildlife and Marine Resources regulations will be enforced, including take limits and size limits, types of fishing, and equipment used.
7. No fishing in roped off areas for swimming.
8. Adequate adult supervision is required of all groups using facilities. Permission for use of the facilities may be denied should a question in regards to ample supervision arise.
9. We ask that after any use of the facilities and areas within the park grounds, please clean up any trash or debris your party may be responsible for. When renting the clubhouse, please clean up any mess associated with your rental, including floors, and take all trash to the dumpster located near the entrance to the park. This will strongly effect whether the \$25.00 deposit is returned. If your party desires to use the fireplace, please inform the Recreation Department beforehand. Do not leave an active fire in the fireplace upon departure from the park.

ALL PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS WILL BE STRICTLY ENFORCED. WE HOPE YOU ENJOY THE USE OF LAKE DARPO AND ITS FACILITIES. IF YOU HAVE ANY SUGGESTIONS AS TO HOW OUR FACILITIES COULD SERVE YOU BETTER, PLEASE DO NOT HESITATE TO CALL.
