

NAMING A ROAD/STREET

- 1.) Make a list of names you would like to use. (NO PROPER NAMES ARE ALLOWED) Include at least twenty (20) different names. No duplicate or road names that sound similar are allowed (see road name list under “Online Forms” “E911” at www.darcosc.com)
- 2.) List them in order of choice. Ex. List your first choice, then second and so on. (use attached list)
- 3.) Submit the list to E-911 Addressing (4th Floor, Courthouse) for approval. Helen D. McFadden (843-398-4647)
- 4.) Print the approved Road/Street name on the petition.
- 5.) Have all owners of the Road/Street sign the petition. (Ex. All those who own the property which the road crosses.)
- 6.) Submit the signed petition to E-911 Addressing.
- 7.) Pay for road sign(s), if required.
- 8.) The Road/Street must be in place (or be built). It must be accessible for emergency vehicles (may require Fire Dept inspection). The Planning Commission will map the Road/Street with GPS (drive the road).
- 9.) Paperwork will be completed and new homes can be addressed off of this Road/Street.
