## LAMAR AREA

### Lamar Dixie Youth Ball Fields

Located adjacent to the Governor's Run Golf Course, this complex has three lighted youth size baseball fields, a Tee Ball, one intermediate baseball field, one Girls Softball field, one bathroom facility and one concession facility. A new restroom facility was built by the county in 2009. County Club Road, Lamar 29069

### Spaulding Recreation Area

Located beside the Spaulding Elementary School, this leased facility has one lighted ball field, a playground area, a picnic shelter with cooker, an outdoor basketball court, and one activity building. A new youth football field was constructed in 2010. There are future plans to build a concession/restroom facility at this youth football site. 400 S. Main Street, Lamar 29069

### Lamar Recreation Center

Renovated in 2003, this building includes storage space for athletic equipment, new restrooms, and an activity room for both senior and youth events. A 2003 PARD grant was used to fence in the parking lot and a picnic/playground area was added. In 2009, the county designated this building for rentals. The Darlington County Recreation Department has one part-time employee who oversees the operations of the youth football, the youth basketball, co-ed softball, and the summer playground programs in the Lamar area.

## DARLINGTON AREA

### Sixth Street Ball Field

One lighted adult size ball field with restrooms and concession stand. Sixth Street, Darlington, 29532

### Blue Street Complex

This leased facility, which is located on the Darlington High School property, has four lighted youth baseball fields, two girl's softball fields, and two concession stands. Blue Street, Darlington, 29532

**Recreation Department** Site of the Darlington County Recreation operations. This building has a full size indoor basketball court, dance room, an exercise room, offices, a kitchen, and activity rooms. 300 Sanders St., Darlington 29532

**Jr. High Ball Field and gym** In cooperation with the Darlington County School District, the county recreation personnel use one field and one gym for programs. A PARD grant was used in 2007 to renovate several of the existing facilities at this site. 100 Magnolia St., Darlington, 29532

**Bill Cain Tennis Center** This facility has six tennis courts, a playground area, and a picnic area. Orange St., Darlington, 29532

**BA Gary Complex** This facility owned jointly between the City of Darlington and the Darlington County School District has a football stadium, swimming pool and gymnasium. The gymnasium and swimming pool underwent major renovations in 2009 and 2010.

## **HARTSVILLE AREA**

**Byerly Park (City owned)** This multi-million dollar facility sports 6 regulation size soccer fields with a field house complete with restrooms. Eight softball/baseball fields were constructed between 2005 and 2010, as well as a state-of-the-art track facility. Two youth facilities were added in 2006. The T.B. Thomas Center, a state-of-the-art facility with a gymnasium, classrooms, exercise rooms, etc.. was constructed in 2009 and is now home to all Byerly Park operations. The Hartsville Area Recreation Department staff works alongside city personnel to share operations of this facility. 14th St., Hartsville, 29550

## **SOCIETY HILL AREA**

**Lake Darpo** This nature based park has a 17.5 acre lake for fishing and boating. It also has a clubhouse for public rental complete with restrooms and a kitchen, as well as two covered shelters. The park area has playground equipment, a bathhouse complete with restrooms and showers, an Adirondack type camping shelter, an outdoor basketball court, a tennis court, one full service RV site, one RV site with just water and electricity, a Frisbee Golf course and an outdoor horseshoe facility. Horses welcome. Major renovations to the spillway and boat dock took place in 2010. 180 Lake Darpo Rd., Society Hill, 29593

**St. David's Ballfield** This field was constructed using a 2010 PARD grant. It is a regulation size field. Future plans are to construct a picnic shelter, a restroom/concession building and to light the field. All Society Hill area outdoor sports activities are held at this site. ## **RURAL AREAS**

**Dovesville  
Recreation  
Area**

This facility has one ball field. A 2002 PARD grant was used to construct a modified outside basketball court. The Ballfield was completely rebuilt and a large playground system was added in 2010. Future plans are for a picnic shelter to be constructed at this site. 100 Mont Claire Rd, Darlington, 29540

**Centerville  
Recreation  
Area**

This facility has one lighted outdoor basketball court, one outdoor volleyball court, playground equipment, two concession stands, and one lighted ball field. Recent grants were used to resurface the basketball court and have it professionally painted. A picnic shelter was also built at this site. Home Ave., Hartsville, 29550

**Antioch Ball  
Field**

This facility has one ball field with dugouts and bleachers. Antioch Rd., Hartsville 29550

**Lydia Ball  
Field**

This facility consists of one adult size ball field also used by youth teams in the area. It is completely fenced in and has grandstands, bleachers and dugouts, as well as concession building. A 2003 PARD grant was used to build new dugouts and to replace dilapidated fencing. A PARD grant was used in 2007/2008 to finish fencing, build additional grandstands and build a restroom facility.
