RESOLUTION NO. 808

A Resolution Supplementing The Powers, Duties, And Function Of The County Administrator

WHEREAS, Chapter 1 of Title 4, South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, as amended, vests Darlington County with authority to purchase and hold, for the use of the county, lands and personalty within the limits thereof; and

WHEREAS, Darlington County has the authority to enter into contracts to purchase the option to buy real property (hereinafter referred to as “option contracts”); and


WHEREAS, County Council desires to locate parcels of real property suitable for economic development purposes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the governing body of Darlington County, South Carolina, that the County Administrator is hereby directed to locate parcels of real property within Darlington County that may be suitable for economic development purposes, and the County Administrator is hereby empowered to execute option contracts for Darlington County to purchase those parcels that the County Administrator, in his discretion, finds to be most suitable for economic development purposes; provided, however, no single option shall be purchased for more than Fifteen Thousand Dollars (\$15,000.00) without prior authorization of County Council.


AND BE IT, FURTHER, RESOLVED that nothing within this Resolution No. 808 shall be construed as to divest County Council of the ultimate authority to decide whether to purchase parcels of real property and the terms thereof.

AND BE IT, FURTHER, RESOLVED that the supplemental powers, duties, and functions of the County Administrator as conferred by this Resolution No. 808 shall expire December 31, 2026, unless sooner codified by ordinance.
